Over recent months we have kept in touch in a variety of ways, and high on the list has been the telephone. I remember, throughout April and most of May, whenever I phoned anyone they always seemed to be in! It's changed a bit now as the Lockdown restrictions are slowly being eased. So, this month I seem to be leaving far more answerphone messages – which I think is a good thing!

On Sunday we began a new phase at AFC with regard to our pattern of worship. The audio service was listened to by just over 70 people, 42 folk attended the 10.30 service in person, and over 80 took a look at the video service once it was posted on-line. We are grateful to everyone who made 'in person' worship possible and to the congregation for acting so responsibly and keeping to the guidelines as posted on the website.

By now I suspect many of you will have heard that our friend and church member Dr Ella Munro MBE has passed away. We honour Ella's fellowship and service among us. She played a full part in the life of our church and her work in the establishment of the Sycamore Club has been a positive blessing to so many families. Ella will be laid to rest at the Great Missenden cemetery at a graveside service for her family next Friday morning at 11.30am (17th July 2020).
