We want you then to make your way calmly & safely out of the building. Stewards & others will be on hand to direct you. If it's raining you won't have to go outside, just get to a fire exit. Those who will be counting, clearing up in the kitchen & anyone who prefers to remain in the hall can do so but you will need to be aware that the fire alarm will sound as a test for a short time.
